- 1973 World Figure Skating Champion. Championships were held in Bratislava, Czechoslovakia and she placed first in all three categories: overall, freestyle and compulsory figures)
- 1971 World Bronze Medallist and 1972 World Silver Medallist
- Silver medallist at the 1972 Winter Olympic Games in Sapporo Japan (only Canadian to win a medal at the Games)
- Five time Canadian Senior Champion in 1968, 1970, 1971, 1972, 1973 and two time Silver Medallist at the event in 1967 and 1969
- Silver Medallist at the 1969 and Gold Medallist at the 1971 North American Senior Ladies Championship
- Voted Canada's athlete of the year for two consecutive years in 1971 and 1972
- Inducted into the Canadian Amateur Athletic Hall of Fame and the Canadian Sports Hall of Fame
- First public skating appearance was as a "snowflake" in the winter carnival at age six
